All book purchases will include a 20% tax-deductible contribution to the Arts Council and will be sales-tax-free for this event. In addition, one of the best-selling authors will be featured at a benefit lunch, held at a private home from noon to 3 pm on the same date, with the proceeds supporting the Arts Council.
