Summer stock comes to Greenwich by way of the Greenwich Arts Council! On Sunday, August 24, at 4 pm in the Cole Auditorium of Greenwich Library, the Greenwich Arts Council will present the Barrington Stage Company Musical Theatre Lab workshop world premiere of the new musical *SEE ROCK CITY & Other Destinations*.

Winner of the Richard Rodgers and Jerry Bock Awards for New Musical, *SEE ROCK CITY & Other Destinations* is fueled by a pop-rock score by Adam Mathias (book & lyrics) and Brad Alexander (music). Billed as a "musical travelogue," it is a collection of short musicals set at tourist destinations across the country - from Rock City to Niagara Falls, stopping off at Coney Island, Route 66 and the Alamo. Each landmark introduces a new set of characters struggling to connect, to move past their fears and expectations in order to fully engage with each other.

SEE ROCK CITY & Other Destinations is directed by Kevin Del Aguila, with music direction by Vadim Feichtner and features a cast of seven extraordinarily talented performers with extensive Broadway, off-Broadway, and regional credits.

Last season the Greenwich Arts Council introduced the Barrington Stage Company's Musical Theatre Lab (with Tony-Award winner William Finn as its Artistic Producer and Julianne Boyd as Artistic Director) to Greenwich audiences with the original musical *The Mysteries of Harris Burdick*. That production brought great acclaim to BSC and GAC, winning praise from critics throughout the Northeast. Barrington Stage Company (Tony Award-winning regional theatre) and the Greenwich Arts Council proudly present *SEE ROCK CITY & Other Destinations* for all to enjoy as the final event in this year's Greenwich Summer Music Series. Admission is free and seating is on a first come, first served basis. The doors will open for the general public at 3:30 pm.
